Tentative Itinerary

Day 1:
Depart for Frankfurt, Germany.

Day 2-6:
German exchange program arranged by school.

Day 7:
Depart for Munich, the capital of Bavaria.
Visit **Dachau**, where we will tour the WWII concentration camp outside of Munich. See **BMW World** and the **Olympic Stadium** from the 1972 games. Tour the historical district, Altes Rathaus, Marienplatz, and the Viktualienmarkt.

Day 8:
Morning tour of the **Nymphenburg Palace** and also tour the **Residenz Palace**. In the afternoon depart for Garmisch – Partenkirchen, a beautiful Bavarian town located on the German-Austrian border. Visit the site of the 1936 Winter Olympic Games and enjoy a walk and shopping in historic Partenkirchen.

Day 9:
Cogwheel train to the top **Zugspitze peak** and then the cable ride down (the steepest in Europe). While at the top of the mountain, look across the peaks of the German, Austrian, Italian, and Swiss Alps, and optional skiing or boarding. Visit the spectacular **Neuschwanstein Castle** built by Mad King Ludwig.

Day 10:
Travel to **Oberammergau** and visit the famous Passion Play house, the site of the longest running Passion Play in the world, dating back centuries. Cross into Austria and travel to **Innsbruck** for a tour of the **Schloss Ambras** and time in the historic city center. Continue to Salzburg for a tour of the historic city center and Salzburg Cathedral. If time visit the **Hohensalzburg Fortress**, a massive castle 400 feet above Salzburg.

Day 11:
Visit to the **Hallstatt Salt Mines**, where your tour will take you through the oldest salt mine in existence. Afternoon exploring the lakes around Hallstatt.

Day 12:
Additional touring this morning around Hallstatt.
Depart for Munich or Vienna.

Day 13:
Depart for home from Munich or Vienna.
